FOR THE ACADEMIC YEAR 2019-20

I. INTRODUCTION

The Institute of Paramedical Sciences, part of the Anjarakandy –Integrated Campus, has been established with the aim of imparting quality education and training in the various disciplines of health sciences.

The Institution has been developed without State subsidy as a fully self financed Centre of Higher Learning. Hence the finance for the infrastructure and expenses for the conduct of courses are to be met from the fees collected from the students.

II. COURSES OF STUDY

The Institute offers the following courses of study for the academic Year 2019-20:

B.P.T. (Bachelor in Physiotherapy) - Duration: 4 ½ years

B.Sc (MLT) – - Duration: 4 years

Name of the courses, duration, eligibility for admission and the details of fee structure are given in Table 1 & 2 below.

Notes:-

1. Usual relaxation in the required minimum marks will be allowed to candidates belonging to SC/ST, and other Eligible Communities.
2. Rules of reservation prescribed by the Kerala University of Health Sciences will be strictly followed for admissions.
3. The course is being conducted on the basis of a Memorandum of Understanding signed between the University and the Institute.

III. This Prospectus contains the rules and regulations for selection and admission to BPT and B.Sc MLT Courses in The Institute of Paramedical Sciences – Kannur Medical College, against the sanctioned intake for the academic year 2019-20.

The conditions in this Prospectus, including fee structure, admission process, etc., are subject to modification/addition/deletion as may be deemed necessary by the Management as well as the competent authorities concerned.

IV. ADMISSION

1. Admission to the Courses will be on the basis of merit.
2. Allotment to 50% of the total seats will be made by the Government, if a consensual agreement is signed with the Government. 50% of the remaining seats come under 'Management quota'.

2. SC/ST/OEC students will be eligible for fee concession as is being followed at present in the institution. Eligible students have to apply for fee concession in the prescribed form in order to get the fee reimbursed from the concerned Department of the Govt. of Kerala within one month from the date of admission.

3. Fee once remitted will not be refunded under any circumstance.
4. Examination fee is to be remitted as per University Notification from time to time.

VI. HOW TO APPLY

- Application for admission to course BPT and B Sc (MLT) course can be registered only online through a single application. The provision for applying online is available at the website www.anjarakandy.in or <https://ipms.anjarakandy.in>
- Candidates should complete all formalities including uploading of the necessary certificates and documents on or before the last date notified for the same.
- The candidates who successfully submitted the online application will automatically be issued with an acknowledgement.
- All fields marked with an asterisk (*) are mandatory.
- Payment towards the application fee of Rs.1000/- , can be made using pay by DD favoring Principal Institute of Paramedical Sciences – Kannur Medical College, payable at Kannur.
- Application will only be processed once the application fee is received.
- If anybody wants to apply for more than one course, separate application form with payment is required.

VII. GENERAL INFORMATION

- Only self attested photocopies of the mark lists, certificates and other documents needed to be sent along with the application.
- Candidates should bring the originals of the certificates/mark list at the time of interview.
- The fact that candidates have been called for interview does not confer on him/her any claim for selection. The admission lists are provisional and subject to confirmation by the University.
- The Institute will not be responsible for the non receipt of applications, interview memos and other correspondence regarding admission.
- All candidates are required to check the rank list and date of interview/admission in the college website.
- If any candidate who is provisionally selected, fails to report to the Officer concerned on or before the specified time and date, his/her selection stands automatically cancelled without any further information, and the seat will be given to the next eligible person in the rank list.

VIII. DEALING WITH FRAUDULENT INFORMATION

Admission to the Courses is purely provisional and if any fraud is detected at any stage in the mark list or certificate produced by the candidate, his/her admission will automatically be cancelled and he/she be removed from the rolls and appropriate legal procedure will be initiated by the Institution against such candidates.

IX. AGREEMENT

All students are required to sign an agreement with the institution to the effect that they will abide by the rules and regulations framed by the University regarding the conduct of the courses.

X ADMISSION PROCESS:

XI. DOCUMENTS TO BE ATTACHED WITH THE APPLICATION FORM:

- Attested copy of SSLC or equivalent Certificate in proof of date of birth.
- Attested copy of Pass Certificate and copy of Mark List of the qualifying examination
- Attested copy of the community certificate/income certificate, if mark relaxation is claimed.
- Copy of Aadhaar Id Card

XII. DOCUMENTS IN ORIGINAL TO BE PRODUCED AT THE TIME OF ADMISSION:

- SSLC or equivalent Certificate in proof of date of birth.
- Pass Certificate and Mark List of the qualifying examination.
- Community certificate/income certificate, if mark relaxation is claimed.
- Eligibility/equivalency certificate obtained from the Kerala University of Health Sciences by candidates who have passed the qualifying examination from authorities other than the State of Kerala/CBSE/ISCE.
- A Physical Fitness Certificate in the prescribed format obtained from a Medical Officer in Government service not below the rank of Asst. Medical Officer.
- Course and conduct certificate from the Institution last attended.
- Transfer Certificate (TC) from the Institution last attended.
- 3 Passport size Photographs.

XIII. GENERAL:

- It is the responsibility of the candidates to check carefully whether all the columns in the application are filled in and signed and all documents, as required to be produced along with the application are enclosed.

- Application not accompanied by application fee and documents will be summarily rejected. Application fee or documents or certificates produced after submission of the application will not be entertained.
- No concession in fee or exemption from payment of fees will be allowed to any candidate.
- For genuine reasons, the Management will have the right to deny admission to any candidate even if he/she is eligible and such reasons will be recorded and informed to the candidates.
- Any complaint regarding rank list, allotment, etc., may be sent in writing to the Director (Admission), with a copy to the Principal, prior to starting of allotment process.

XIV. REFUND/ADJUSTMENT OF FEES

- No refund of fee will be made to candidates who apply for Transfer Certificate/Cancellation of admission under any circumstance, after the cut-off date for taking admission by candidates. They will have to pay Liquidated damages.
- If any candidate, on discontinuance of course in the first year, after the cut off date for closing of admissions fixed by the Government, for joining other courses/Colleges or for other purposes are liable to pay liquidated damages equal to 4 times of the annual tuition fee paid by them for the first year irrespective of annual family income/nativity/reservation status.
- If any candidate discontinues the Course or leaves the Institution, during the entire course of study, due to any reason, the tuition fee for the remaining period shall have to be paid as liquidated damage. This is applicable to everyone irrespective of Govt allotment/Management quota/Financial status/Caste/Religion.
- Transfer Certificate will be issued only on payment of liquidating damage.

XV. CAUTION AGAINST RAGGING

- Ragging, which is a criminal offence as per the existing Rules, is strictly prohibited in the Campus, class room and Hostels. An undertaking by candidates and parents shall be taken in this regard before the commencement of every academic year.
