I. INTRODUCTION

The Institute of Paramedical Sciences, part of the Anjarakandy –Integrated Campus, has been established with the aim of imparting quality education and training in the various disciplines of health sciences.

The Institution has been developed without State subsidy as a fully self financed Centre of Higher Learning. Hence the finance for the infrastructure and expenses for the conduct of courses are to be met from the fees collected from the students.

- II.** This Prospectus contains the rules and regulations for selection and admission to BPT and BSc MLT Courses in The Institute of Paramedical Sciences – Kannur Medical College, against the sanctioned intake for the academic year **2023 - 24**.

The conditions in this Prospectus, including fee structure, admission process, etc. are subject to modification/addition/deletion as may be deemed necessary by the Management as well as the competent authorities concerned.

III. COURSES OF STUDY

The Institute offers the following courses of study for the academic Year **2023 - 24**.

B.P.T. (Bachelor in Physiotherapy) - Duration: 4 ½ years

BSc (MLT) – - Duration: 4 years

IV. ADMISSION

1. Admission to the Courses will be on the basis of merit.
2. Allotment to 50% of the total seats will be made by the Government, if a consensual agreement is signed with the Government. 50% of the remaining seats come under 'Management quota'.

COURSES OF STUDY

1. B.P.T. (Bachelor of Physiotherapy)	4 ½ Years	30	Candidates who have passed Higher Secondary examination of the Board of Higher Secondary Education, Kerala, or examinations recognized equivalent thereto, with 50% marks in Biology and 50% marks in Physics, Chemistry and Biology put together are eligible. Besides they should have studied English as a subject at 12 th standard/Plus Two levels.
2. B.Sc. Medical Lab Technology (BSc.MLT)	4 Years	30	Candidates who have passed Higher Secondary examination of the Board of Higher Secondary Education, Kerala, or examinations recognized equivalent thereto, with 50% marks in Physics, Chemistry, Biology and English put together are eligible.

Notes:-

- Usual relaxation in the required minimum marks will be allowed to candidates belonging to SC/ST, and other Eligible Communities.
- Rules of reservation prescribed by the Kerala University of Health Sciences will be strictly followed for admissions.
- The course is being conducted on the basis of a Memorandum of Understanding signed between the University and the Institute.

VI. HOW TO APPLY

All candidates seeking admission to the Paramedical Degree courses, under Management Quota must apply only online in the website www.anjarakandy.in or <http://ipms.anjarakandy.in> from **05.06.2023** onwards. Last date for submitting online application is **05.07.2023** before **5pm**. During the submission of online application, candidates have to enter the marks obtained by them in the subjects concerned in their Qualifying Examination, in the website.

VII. SELECTION AND ADMISSION

1. Selection of the candidates for management quota will be done among the candidates who have only successfully applied in the college website, based on the marks obtained in the qualifying examination under rank list put up by the management.
2. The Selected candidates will be informed via mobile calls and mail regarding the date and time of their interview for the admission into the course.
3. The fact that candidates have been called for interview does not confer on him/her any claim for selection into the course.
4. If any candidate who is provisionally selected, fails to report to the Principal on or before the specified time and date, his/her selection stands automatically cancelled without any further information, and the seat will be given to the next eligible person in the rank list.
5. The Institute will not be responsible if the selected candidate has given an invalid contact number or mail and also if the selected candidate does not respond to the interview calls and mail.

VIII. GENERAL INFORMATION

- Candidates should bring the originals of the certificates/mark list at the time of interview.
- The fact that candidates have been called for interview does not confer on him/her any claim for selection. The admission lists are provisional and subject to confirmation by the University.
- The Institute will not be responsible for the non receipt of applications, interview memos and other correspondence regarding admission.
- All candidates are required to check the rank list and date of interview/admission in the college website.
- If any candidate who is provisionally selected, fails to report to the Officer concerned on or before the specified time and date, his/her selection stands automatically cancelled without any further information, and the seat will be given to the next eligible person in the rank list.

IX. DEALING WITH FRAUDULENT INFORMATION

Admission to the Courses is purely provisional and if any fraud is detected at any stage in the mark list or certificate produced by the candidate, his/her admission will automatically be cancelled and he/she be removed from the rolls and appropriate legal procedure will be initiated by the Institution against such candidates.

X. AGREEMENT

All students are required to sign an agreement with the institution to the effect that they will abide by the rules and regulations framed by the University regarding the conduct of the courses.

X I. ADMISSION PROCESS:

XII. DOCUMENTS IN ORIGINAL TO BE PRODUCED AT THE TIME OF ADMISSION:

- SSLC or equivalent Certificate in proof of date of birth.
- Pass Certificate and Mark List of the qualifying examination.
- Eligibility/equivalency certificate obtained from the Kerala University of Health Sciences by candidates who have passed the qualifying examination from authorities other than the State of Kerala/CBSE/ISCE.
- A Physical Fitness Certificate in the prescribed format obtained from a Medical Officer in Government service not below the rank of Asst. Medical Officer.
- Course and conduct certificate from the Institution last attended.
- Transfer Certificate (TC) and Conduct Certificate (CC) from the Institution last attended.
- 3 Passport size Photographs.
- Aadhar card copy.
- Migration certificate.

XIII. GENERAL:

- It is the responsibility of the candidates to check carefully whether all the columns in the application are filled in and signed and all documents, as required to be produced along with the application are enclosed.
- Application not accompanied by application fee and documents will be summarily rejected. Application fee or documents or certificates produced after submission of the application will not be entertained.
- No concession in fee or exemption from payment of fees will be allowed to any candidate.

- For genuine reasons, the Management will have the right to deny admission to any candidate even if he/she is eligible and such reasons will be recorded and informed to the candidates.
- Any complaint regarding rank list, allotment, etc., may be sent in writing to the Principal, prior to starting of allotment process.

XIV. REFUND/ADJUSTMENT OF FEES

- No refund of fee will be made to candidates who apply for Transfer Certificate/Cancellation of admission under any circumstance, after the cut-off date for taking admission by candidates. They will have to pay Liquidated damages.
- If any candidate, on discontinuance of course in the first year, after the cutoff date for closing of admissions fixed by the Government, for joining other courses/Colleges or for other purposes are liable to pay liquidated damages equal to 4 times of the annual tuition fee paid by them for the first year irrespective of annual family income/nativity/reservation status.
- If any candidate discontinues the Course or leaves the Institution, during the entire course of study, due to any reason, the tuition fee for the remaining period shall have to be paid as liquidated damage. This is applicable to everyone irrespective of Govt allotment/Management quota/Financial status/Caste/Religion.
- Transfer Certificate will be issued only on payment of liquidated damage.

XV. CAUTION AGAINST RAGGING

- Ragging, which is a criminal offence as per the existing Rules, is strictly prohibited in the Campus, class room and Hostels. An undertaking by candidates and parents shall be taken in this regard before the commencement of every academic year.
